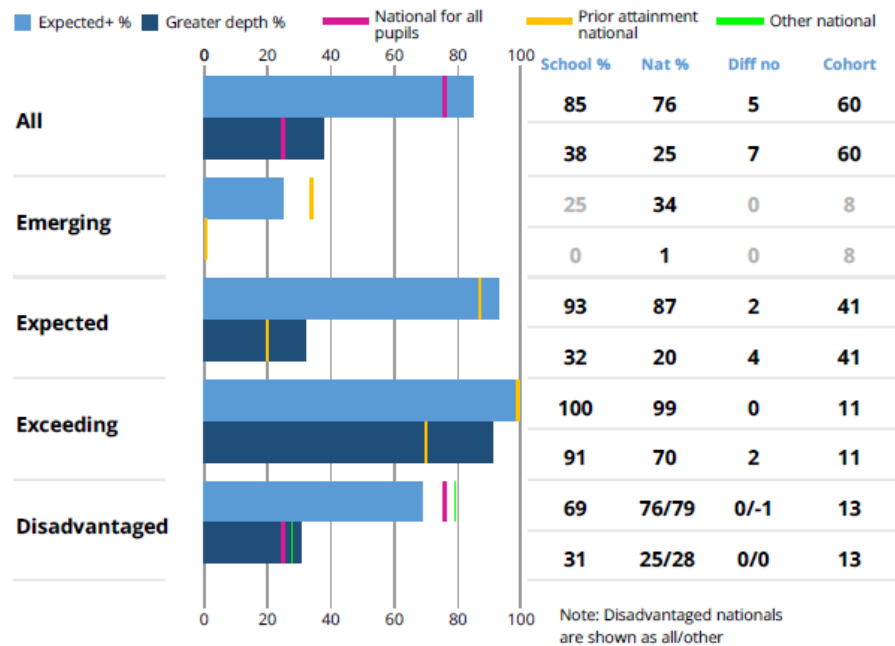


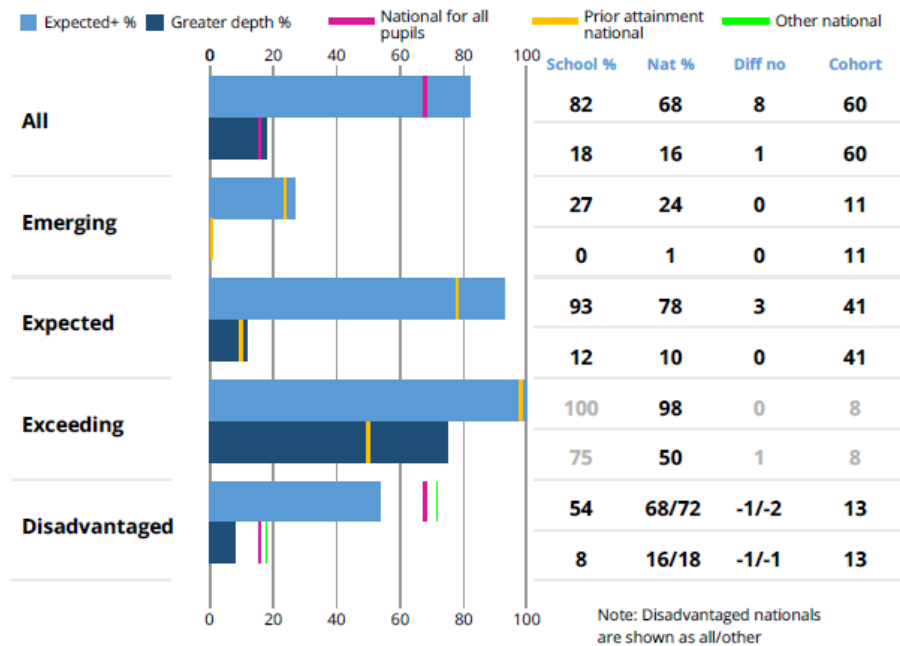

As the tables below show the school continues to be successful in all year groups being above local and national average in end of key stage assessments.

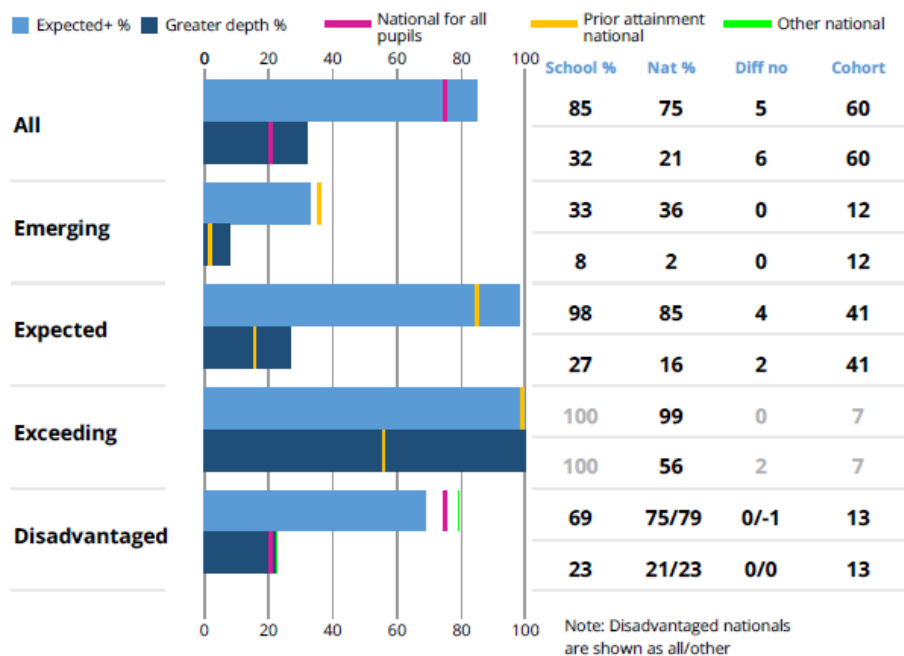
Reading in 2017



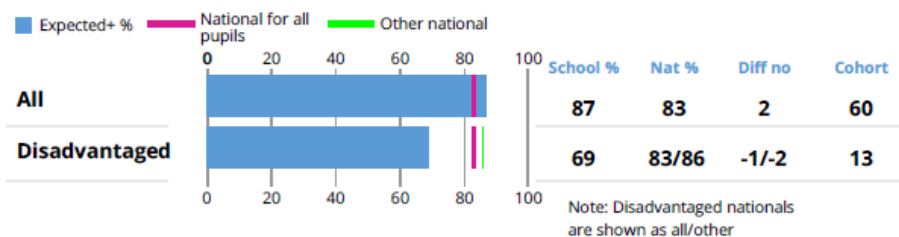
Writing in 2017

Science in 2017

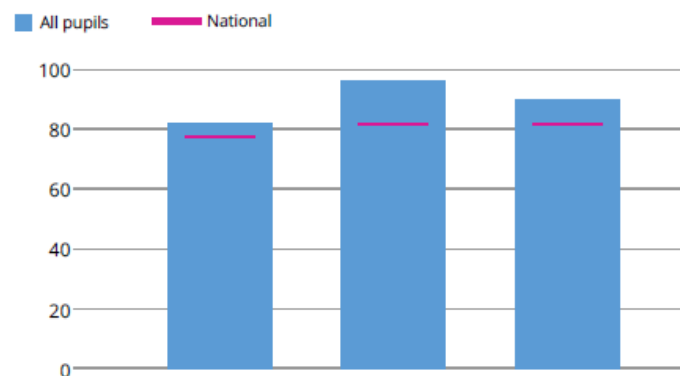


Phonic Screening Results 2017

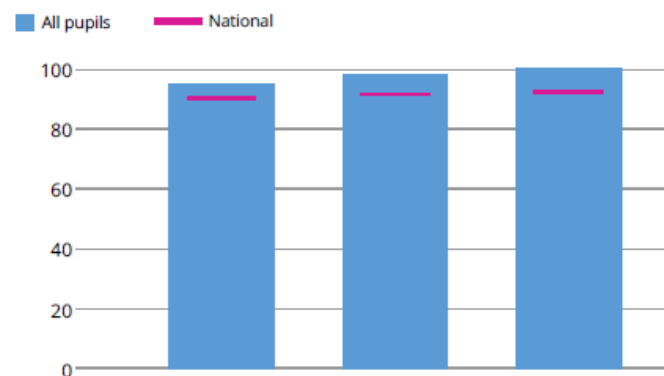
