## YEAR TWO CURRICULUM AUTUMN TERM 2018

An outline of this term's curriculum is described here for your information which we hope you will find of interest. The Autumn term's work will be based on the theme of 'Fire! Fire!' This will be covered through our exciting creative curriculum whereby the children will receive a package containing a variety of objects from the past and will use a variety of information sources to research these items and their association with a famous event from the past.




### English

The children will be expected to write independently in a variety of genres. This will include descriptions of characters and fantasy settings, writing in the role of a famous character and narrative writing. They will be reinforcing their work on sentence structure and learning how to extend their sentences through the use of conjunctions. They will be using question and exclamation marks in their writing.



### Maths

The children will use the symbols  $+$ ,  $-$ ,  $\times$ ,  $\div$  and  $=$  to record and interpret number sentences involving all four operations and apply their knowledge to solve problems using these operations including those with money. The children will explain and record their calculations in number sentences. They will use standard measures (grams, litres, metres and hours) and recognise fractions of a shape including quarters and thirds.



### Science

The children will develop their scientific skills when learning. They will investigate and sort a variety of materials according to their properties. They will investigate how these materials are suited to different purposes.



### Music

This term's music is focused around the song: Hands, Feet and Heart. The children will explore pulse, pitch and rhythm through playing games, singing and playing instruments.



### Geography



The work this term will be based on learning about London and its landmarks. The children will use laptops to research. They will learn now to create maps and simple keys.

## History

This term the children will continue to develop their historical skills of enquiry by learning about the lives of famous people and events from the past. They will learn to use different sources to draw conclusions about why past events happened as they did.



## Art

The children will explore primary and secondary colours to create a piece of art work linked to the creative curriculum. They will also study the work of Monet and create a piece of work inspired by his work.



## Design and Technology

The children will design and make a Christmas stocking and will also be learning to cook a healthy dish each term.



## ICT

Once again this term the children will have the opportunity to use our extensive range of ICT equipment to support other curriculum areas and develop specific ICT skills. This term the main focus will be for children to create a poster using the ipads linked to our learning this term and use the internet as a research tool.



## Physical Education

In gymnastics the children will develop a range of movements and learn how to link these together. They will continue to practise throwing and catching and use these in simple games. There will be a weekly Zumba class.



## Religious Education

This term the programme of study will encourage the children to appreciate that different religions have different celebrations. They will look at special festivals that take place this term including Christmas.
